4 Day Riveting Course – Summary.

On receipt of a deposit the Candidates will be sent a pre-course assignment consisting of 4 questions. This will be sent to you approx. 4 weeks prior to starting the practical course and should be handed in on your first day of the four day course.

DAY ONE.

This consists of housekeeping – knowing your working environment – discussions of your previous knowledge – Health and safety with reference to the equipment you will use – workshop visit and familiarisation of tools to be used.

DAY TWO.

Discussing the different types of rivets and their material specification – start the practical side of riveting – removal of rivets including drilling and oxy/acetylene cutting, grinding, and heating of rivets – working in teams.

DAY THREE.

Further practice until lunchtime – final test pieces to be completed and marked for identification purposes.

DAY FOUR.

In the morning a question and answer session will be held with the candidates, while the test pieces are being examined by an independent assessor.
Before departing each Trainee will be called individually to go through the pre-course exam papers and the question and answer session. In some cases the candidate will be coached accordingly.
Each candidate will then be given a pass/fail and where appropriate will be sent a Certificate at a later date.
Completion of a written feedback sheet will be required to be filled in.

The cost of the course is £845.00. per person and includes all materials and the provision of Safety helmets, goggles, leather apron and leather gloves.
